### Facilities

Spartan athletes have access to outstanding facilities that include: Spartan Hall, Emerson Field, the Cayuga's Fitness Center, an Athletic Training Room, Coaching Office Suites, and updated locker and team room areas.

Spartan Hall houses the main indoor facility on-campus, and plays home to Spartan basketball on the arena's new hardwood floor, installed in the summer of 2007. A new SportCourt floor was installed for volleyball in the Summer of 2010. The remainder of the facility can host a variety of team practices on its multi-purpose floor, including soccer and lacrosse.

Emerson Field hosts outdoor contests and practices for soccer and lacrosse. Highland Park Golf Club plays host to the golf team... while Falcons Lanes hosts the bowling program.

### Men's Lacrosse

The men's lacrosse team plays arguably the most competitive regional and conference schedule in NJCAA lacrosse in the country. The Spartans have made NJCAA Region III Tournaments appearances in five of the last seven seasons, and finished ranked 10th nationally in the final 2006 NJCAA poll. Several players have continued their playing careers by continuing on to four-year institutions after Cayuga.

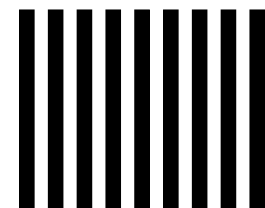
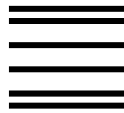
