Types of Financial Aid

Student Loans

Are financial aid that **you must pay back**. Cayuga's Financial Aid office can help you obtain Ford Federal Direct Student Loans.

Grants

Come from federal and state sources. Grants handled by Cayuga's financial aid office include Pell, TAP, FSEOG, Nursing, Aid to Part-Time Students, and Federal Work-Study, **you do not have to pay back**.

Scholarships

Scholarships are forms of financial aid that **you do not have to pay back**. To be considered for most scholarships and grants at Cayuga, you need to apply early. How to Apply for Financial Aid

- 1 Apply to Cayuga**
Stop in the Admissions office to enroll.
- 2 Get a PIN**
Request your personal identification number (PIN) for you and your parent if providing parent information at www.pin.edu.gov
- 3 Complete the Free (FAFSA) Application**
at www.fafsa.ed.gov
Cayuga's school code is 002861
- 4 New York State Residents**
Full-time students will be directed to the online Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) at the end of the FAFSA application

Cayuga's TAP code is 2005
Part-time students use the APTS application at www.cayuga-cc.edu/financial_aid/apply.php
- 5 Check Your Banner ID**
Once you are registered for classes check your Cayuga student assigned banner ID to see what grants, scholarships, loans or work-study assistance you are eligible to receive.
Note: You must reapply for financial aid each academic year.
