## Honors Study at Cayuga

The Honors Study option is designed for academically motivated students wishing to study the liberal arts and sciences and ultimately preparing to transfer to a four-year program.

### Honors Study At Cayuga

Honors Study is not a degree program in itself, but rather an enhanced learning experience where students are intellectually challenged in a manner consistent with their ability and interests. Honors students graduate with an Associate in Arts or an Associate in Science in their chosen program of study, but with the distinction of an "Honors Study" degree. The honors experience develops qualities of leadership and service, which often extend beyond the classroom, and which are supported by dynamic faculty, rigorous academic expectations, and a sense of community.

### Admission

Any student with a GPA of 3.0 or 85% or higher is eligible for admission. Students who do not meet the criteria when they enter CCC may join after as little as one semester by earning a 3.0 GPA. Once accepted, you must maintain a 3.0 GPA.

### Learning In And Beyond The Classroom

Honors students take the same courses as other students, but have the opportunity to take Honors sections of courses. Honors courses provide a multidisciplinary perspective and/or learning beyond the classroom while emphasizing writing, discussions, problem-solving, and critical and creative thinking.

### The Honors Curriculum

The Honors sequence complements study in transfer-oriented degree programs, and is designed to fulfill SUNY General Education requirements. At least six Honors-designated courses are needed to complete the Honors requirements. Course selection is flexible, and students work with advisers to tailor their choices to their academic goals.

### Students Must Complete Five Honors Courses Selected From:

- Honors sections of courses that fulfill SUNY general education requirements
- Honors sections of courses that provide depth in a specific discipline
- Honors Seminars

### Students Must Complete One Non-Traditional Course Selected From:

- Spring Break travel-study Art course in New York City *includes additional fees beyond tuition*
- Intercession travel-study course in London (Art, Business, Criminal Justice, History, Health Care, Sociology, Literature, Media, World Religions and Theatre) *includes additional fees beyond tuition*
- Intercession travel-study course in Florida (Native American Culture and Education with the Seminole Indians) *includes additional fees beyond tuition*
- Independent Honors Study courses
- Internships

### Honors Scholarships
