

Want to get started?

You can enroll in online courses just as you would for a classroom course. If you plan to pursue a Cayuga degree, either full-time or part-time, start by contacting the Admissions office at admissions@cayuga-cc.edu or 888.598.8883.

If you do not plan to pursue a Cayuga degree or are already enrolled as a Cayuga student, you can register for online courses directly with the Registrar's office. Cayuga's Business office and Financial Aid office serve online students also. Contact information and application forms for Cayuga offices are available at the College website: www.cayuga-cc.edu.

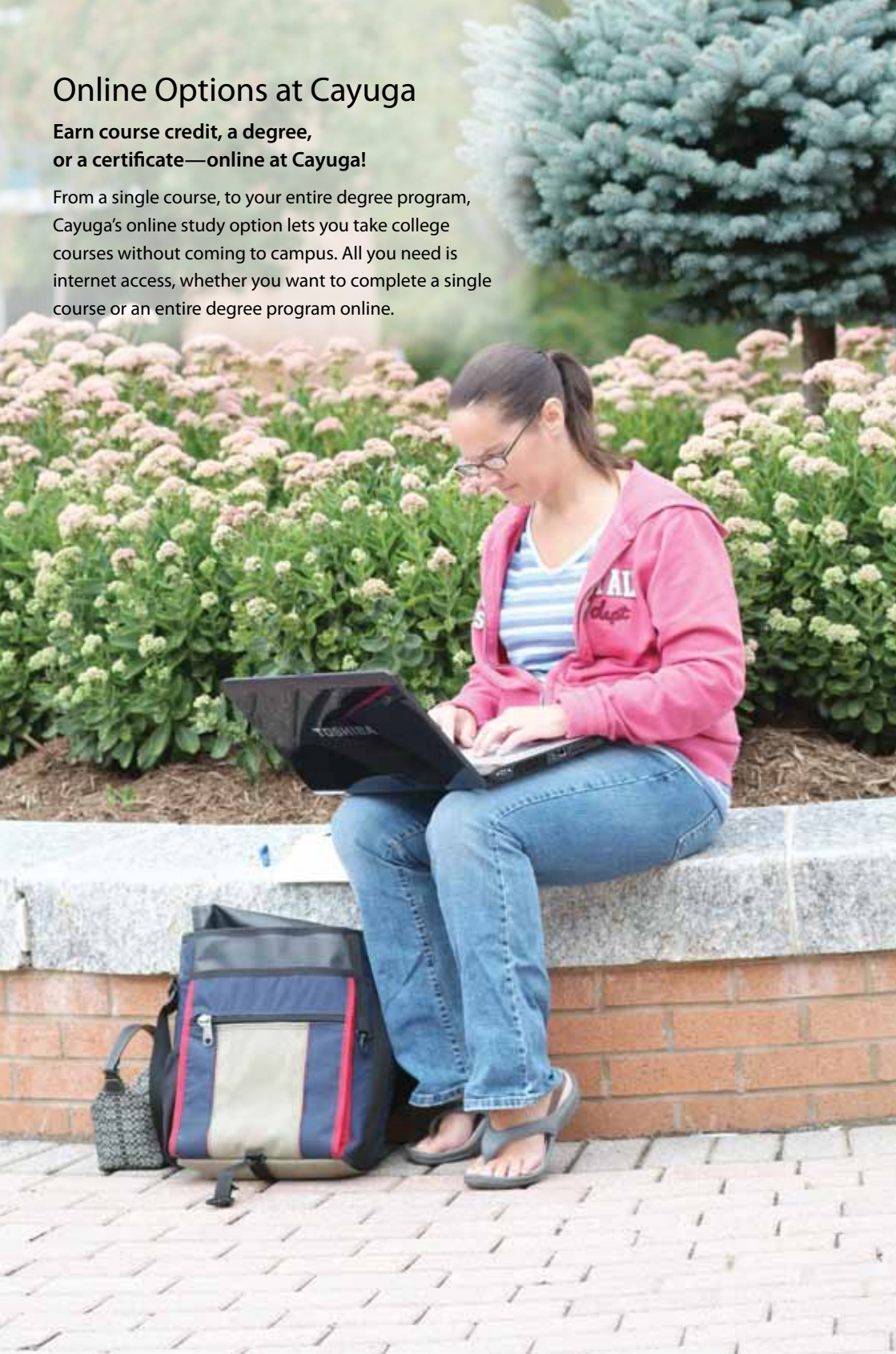

Online Options at Cayuga

Earn course credit, a degree, or a certificate—online at Cayuga!

From a single course, to your entire degree program, Cayuga's online study option lets you take college courses without coming to campus. All you need is internet access, whether you want to complete a single course or an entire degree program online.



Each year, Cayuga offers more than 350 credit courses online.

Many Cayuga students find that online study provides valuable flexibility to fit college courses into their busy schedule. For others, online study at Cayuga is an affordable way to earn transfer credits toward a degree elsewhere. Still others live far from a college campus, and use Cayuga's online option to pursue a degree through distance learning.

During any session, you can mix and match online and on-campus courses at Cayuga.

In Cayuga's online courses, students get assignments, take part in discussions, and submit papers and projects over the internet. Small classes are a hallmark of Cayuga Community College, and the same is true for online study, with no more than 25 students in a section. And Cayuga's online instructors meet the same professional qualifications as classroom faculty.

Is Online Study Right for You?

If you're comfortable using the internet, and a motivated learner who can meet deadlines without a scheduled class time, online study may be an ideal way to help meet your higher education goals.



Six Cayuga associate degree programs are available fully online.

Six Cayuga associate degrees (see the back of this brochure) can be earned entirely online. Others can be completed through a combination of online and on-campus study. Whether

you enroll for one course or pursue your degree completely online, you'll find similarities to, and differences from, the traditional classroom.

For several degree programs, more than half of the coursework can be completed online.

As an online student, you'll have password access to your course website. You will be responsible for obtaining any required textbooks and materials. Typically, a course consists of a series of two-week modules. In each module, you'll be expected to read the textbook and other materials, read faculty lectures online, submit answers to questions, complete other assignments, and join in discussions posted on the website. Generally, you will need to log on to the website about three times per week.

Affordable and Accessible

Cayuga is noted for keeping college affordable and accessible, and online study offers these advantages in a distance learning format. Tuition is the same per credit hour as for classroom courses; nominal online course fees apply. Financial aid is available for qualified online students, just as it is for those taking classroom courses. And online students have access to the library's extensive electronic resources for course-related research.

An online course taken at Cayuga will appear on your college transcript (your academic record) exactly as if you had taken it in class, with no indication whether or not it was online.

If you wish to transfer course credit to another institution, you will need to check on and comply with that college's credit approval policy. Cayuga's Transfer Services office is available to help you in planning for a smooth transfer into a bachelor's degree program.
