



DOCUMENTATION GUIDELINES PHYSICAL DISABILITIES

In order to ensure the provision of reasonable and appropriate academic accommodations for students with a disability, the following documentation is needed.

- A statement on letterhead by an attending physician/qualified health professional that includes the nature and current status of the disability, functional limitations, and any recommendations for academic/personal support. These recommendations should be supported by the diagnosis.
- Currently prescribed treatments, medications, assistive devices, and services should be described. Significant side effects that may affect physical, perceptual, or cognitive functioning within the academic setting should be identified and described.
- This documentation must be current and include the name(s) and title(s) of the evaluator(s).
